

**HOWELL TOWNSHIP
SEWER/WATER CONNECTION
PROCEDURE**

SEWER – sewer treatment plant connection

1. **\$4,830.00** payable to Howell Township for System Equity Fee
2. L C B D Plumbing Permit - at Livingston County Building Department
3. Contractor (expense to homeowner):
Contractor **must** call Severn and Trent at 517-719-7486 before opening trench for lead, failure to do so relieves Howell Township from any liability that may be incurred due to incorrectly locating trench.
 - a. To bring sewer line from structure to sewer lead at the road, and
 - b. To retrofit structure from septic to sewer if necessary.
4. Abandon septic system on existing structures, contact Health Department for details 517-546-9850.

WATER – water treatment plant connection

1. **\$4,830.00 – if you have been assessed.
\$8,330.00 – if you have NOT been assessed. \$3,500.00 of this fee is required by MHOG due to their price increase.**
(\$4,830.00 Payable to Howell Township for System Equity Fee and \$3,500.00 payable to MHOG.)
2. Water Meter check to **M H O G** through Howell Township:
 - a. Existing structure **\$556.00**
 - b. New structure **\$556.00 + \$50.00** new user fee = **\$606.00**
ALSO:
 - c. May purchase 1” irrigation meter without PVB (back flow prohibitor)
May purchase 1” irrigation with PVB (back flow prohibitor)
3. L C B D Plumbing permit – at Livingston County Building Department
4. Contractor (expense to homeowner):
 - a. To bring water line from structure to water lead at the road, and
 - b. To retrofit structure from well to public water if necessary.
 - c. Contact M H O G to schedule for meter to be set – 800-881-4109
5. Contact Health Department for details on existing well detachment 517-546-9850.

At this time it is **not** mandatory to hook up to sewer and/or water, **unless**, one of the systems fail then it becomes **mandatory**.

****Sewer and Water District #8 had some opted in and opted out properties: opted out did not have the special assessment spread over twenty years. Again it will be mandatory to hook up to sewer and/or water in this district if one of the systems fails.
